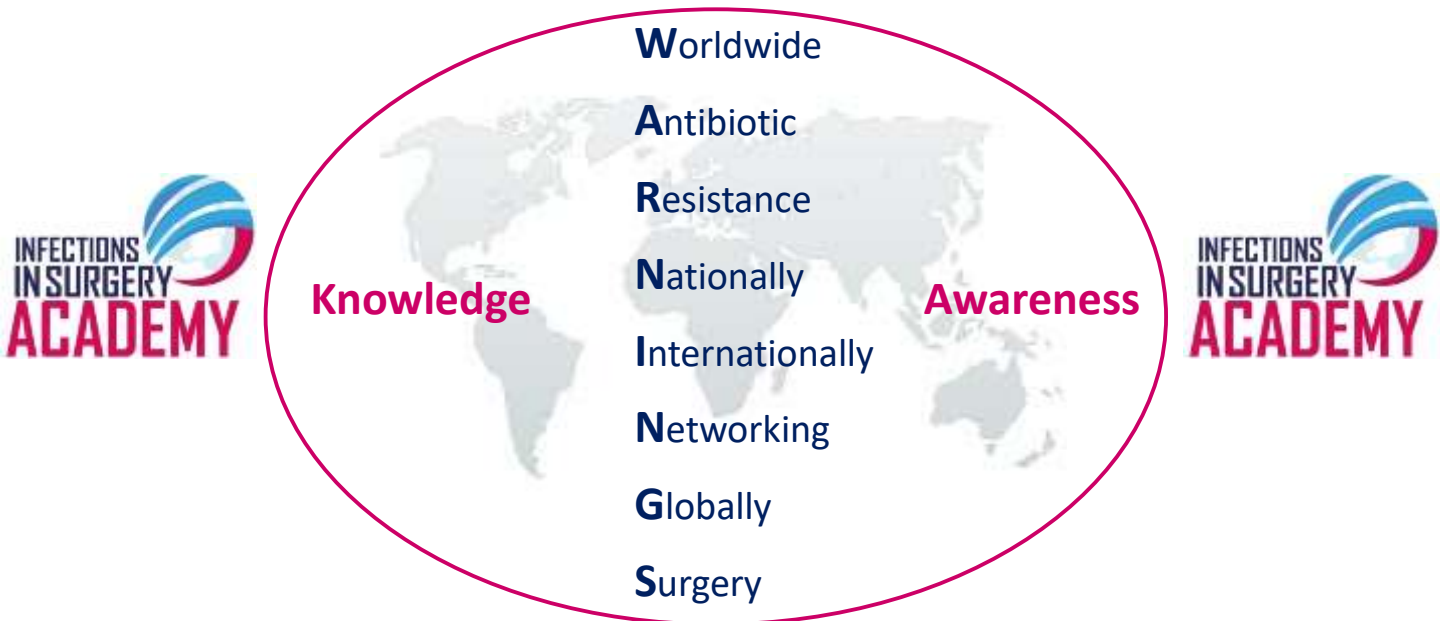




# Free webinar meeting
